The mentoring-program WIN – women into industry is a joint project of the University of Basel and Novartis. WIN has the general aim to support and encourage young and highly qualified female academics to proactively plan and work on their career. For more information see <http://pages.unibas.ch>.

being a mentee

According to your preferences and your scientific background you will be advised and individually coached by an experienced scientist or a professional manager from Novartis. In the workshops you deal with different topics being relevant to working women - such as planning career, networking, job applications, part-time employment or work-life-balance. At the workshops there is provided plenty of time to exchange experiences with the other participants (mentees/mentors).

who can become a mentee

This call addresses female doctoral students or postdoc researchers from the University of Basel with all academic backgrounds (phil I, phil II, medicine, law, economics, psychology, theology). We ask for high motivation to involve yourself in the program and for a high interest in the topics stated above. The program is being run mainly bilingual. Therefore we ask for good knowledge of German and English.

time and structure of the program

The number of participants is limited to 25 mentees. Your mentor will be chosen according to your profile (as far as possible). The mentoring-duos are expected to meet about once a month, working on your individually fixed goals. Besides that there will take place joint workshops for all mentoring-duos. The mentees start with a “welcome” on April 23rd, 2009 (12.15 to 14.30 p.m.). The official kick-off will take place on May 11th, 2009 (10 a.m. to 5 p.m.) and a “stopover” on October 14th, 2009 (12 a.m. to 6 p.m.). The mentoring-program officially ends on April 14th or 21th, 2010 with a workshop and a dinner (12 a.m. to 9 p.m.). The mentees are expected to participate on all the listed events.
